1. Introduction

3. Features

3.1 Accessibility Features

Accessibility features refer to the functionalities integrated into devices, software, or environments to ensure effective utilization by individuals with disabilities. These features are designed to eliminate obstacles and facilitate equitable access to information, communication, and functionality for all users. The features available in the eDHCR portal are as below


3.1.1 Screen Readers

Software that converts text and graphical content into speech or braille output, enabling blind or visually impaired users to access digital content.

The screen reader can be accessed from the first top row in all pages by clicking the “Screen Reader” option available at the top row



The following free software’s are compatible with the portal, If any other software is being used and the user finds any difficulty kindly provide feedback and the same would be looked into in further updates.



3.1.2 Adjustable Font Sizes

Allows users to customize text display settings to suit their preferences and needs to improve readability for those with visual impairments. The magnification option is available in the portal at the first top row in all pages next to the Language dropdown.

There 5 different options to adjust text size and three are shown below for reference.






3.1.3 High Contrast Mode

Adjusts the color scheme of user interfaces to enhance visibility for individuals with low vision or color blindness. The high contrast mode option is available in the portal at the first top row in all pages next to the magnification option with the button “Light/Dark Mode”.



3.1.4 Dictation Software

Enables users to input text by speaking, which can be particularly helpful for individuals with mobility impairments or repetitive strain injuries.

The keywords for searches from Phrase, Any words and All words can be entered into the search box by voice and the results would be loaded automatically based on the available data.



3.1.5 Text-to-Speech


Converts written text into spoken language, benefiting users with dyslexia, cognitive impairments, or those who prefer auditory learning.

This option is available in all the search results when the HTML view is opened providing options for text to speech Start, Play/Pause and Stop respectively.



3.1.6 Bilingual

The dropdown next to the Screen Reader can be accessed to switch to Hindi where in the portal shall be displayed in Hindi to support the users who find it tough to use the portal in English and the vice versa.



3.1.7 Captioning

Captioning is provided in many places to help the users understand what are the features and how to use the same.

By clicking “High Court of Delhi” from any of the pages the user shall be redirected to the landing page.




3.2.2 About eDHCR

HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE VALMIKI J.MEHTA

VALMIKI J. MEHTA, J. (ORAL)

1. The appellant No.1, who is an Advocate, states that he has informed Mr. Atar Singh Tokas, counsel for the respondents, and Mr. Tokas informed him that the respondents have taken back the file from him. I am not inclined to adjourn this old appeal any further as this matter is on the Regular Board of this Court since 2.2.2012.

2. The challenge by means of this Regular First Appeal(RFA) filed under Section 96 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC) is to the impugned judgment and decree of the trial Court dated 13.12.2003 dismissing the suit filed by the appellants/plaintiffs for possession and mesne profits with respect to the suit property bearing MCD No.500/23, Plot No.29, Gali No.10, Bhikam Singh Colony, Behind Masjid, Shahdara, Delhi.

3. The facts of this case are that the appellants/plaintiffs by means of usual documents being the Agreement to Sell, Power of Attorney, Will etc all dated 11.2.2002(Power of Attorney and Will being duly registered with the sub-Registrar, Delhi) purchased the rights in the suit property from one Sh. Sadat Ali Khan. Sh. Sadat Ali Khan had purchased the suit property from Smt. Jasbeer Kaur by means of similar set of documents dated 18.12.1998, and some of which documents are registered documents. Smt. Jasbeer Kaur had purchased the property from Sh.

Chanan Singh vide similar set of documents dated 3.12.1997. Sh. Chanan Singh was the son of Sardar Dasondha Singh, who had purchased the suit property from the original owner, namely, Shree Ram Sarvaria and Sons Ltd. by means of a registered sale deed dated 16.3.1955. The appellants/plaintiffs claimed that the respondents were illegal

3.3.6 Advanced Search: Date of Decision

Enter the date range of the records of the judgment date which shall be shown in the results.



3.3.7 Advanced Search: Neutral Citation

Enter the desired Neutral Citation of the record for the respective search to be loaded. If the judgment is provided by the division bench kindly select from the last drop-down for “-DB”



3.3.8 Advanced Search: Case Number

Enter the case number by selecting the relevant case category along with its case number and selecting the year of case filed from the dropdown. The respective case shall be loaded in the result page.



3.3.9 Advanced Search: Case Category

Select the relevant case category single or multiple based on the requirement for all the cases of the selected categories to be loaded in the results page.
